


Call for Papers



CNEHA's 2019 annual meeting will be held at the Fort William Henry Hotel & Conference Center in Lake George, New York, on November 7-10, 2019. The theme this year is "Frontiers of War and Industry," reflecting the prominence of this region in the wars of the 18th century and the extractive industries of the 19th century. Individual papers, sessions and posters on these themes, as well as all other aspects of historical archaeology in the Northeast, are welcome.

Abstracts should be no more than 150 words and clearly describe the purpose of the research, the significance of the work and summary of the results. Papers are limited to 20 minutes. All abstracts must be submitted by July 15, 2019. All lead author(s) presenter(s) must be a current member of CNEHA and register for the conference when presenting their abstract. Please submit appropriate conference registration fee with your abstract. Students should include a copy of their student ID.
